MAJOR UPGRADES FOR LINDBLOM PARK

A re-elected Albanese Labor Government would put \$2 million towards upgrading the changerooms and clubrooms at Lindblom Park in Pooraka, home of the Pooraka Football and Cricket Club.

The City of Salisbury has identified the need for this upgrade as part of its Lindblom Reserve Master Plan, which seeks to expand upon the use of the site as a sporting destination for AFL, cricket, football (soccer) and netball.

Pooraka Sports and Social Club, Pooraka All Stars Netball Club and Metro United Women's Football Club operate on the reserve, but facilities at the site are ageing and have failed to keep up with changing needs and demographics.

This election commitment would go towards new changerooms and clubrooms as well as improved facilities including a kiosk and storage shed.

Consistent with past practice, election commitments will be delivered in line with Commonwealth Grants Rules and Principles.
